

Reciprocal Rights Agreement

Between Bunbury Golf Club and Geraldton Golf Club

Members of both clubs are eligible for reciprocal rights subject to and in accordance with the provisions set out below;

- Upon the presentation of evidence of current financial membership from their home club a reciprocal member shall enjoy the golf rights equivalent to that of their home membership category.
- A reciprocal member can play in club competitions, other than Club Championships, trophy events and other major events determined by the Club, subject to payment of applicable entry/competition fees. This reciprocal right does not extend to other member discounts outside the regular competition fee. The reciprocal membership does include social golf rounds.
- A reciprocal member can play a maximum of 6 rounds per calendar year (Excludes Major Open Events), up to a maximum of 8 reciprocal members can play in the one competition. (Approval for additional players subject to availability)
- When entering Club competitions reciprocal members must confirm their current handicap through Golf link or by presentation of a letter from their Club official confirming their GA handicap;
- The reciprocal rights is for FULL PLAYING members only.
- Reciprocal members have access to available amenities of the club house subject to the Clubs by-laws and such conditions which exist from time to time, for example, dress rules, general decorum and acceptable standards of behaviour;
- The benefits provided apply only to members of reciprocal clubs who are temporarily visiting the club.
- Either party giving two (2) months notice in writing may cancel this agreement.


