

TEMPORARY CONDITIONS OF PLAY Revised 13th May, 2020



- Members may invite up to 3 guests from 18th May, green fees and/or comp fees apply, guests to play in the same group as the member
- STRICTLY NO BYO! as this is a condition of our Liquor License.
- Bookings Only, no just turning up. The time sheets will be available online or call the pro shop or the office to make a booking.
- Single tee start, limits the number of people arriving at the same time and try to access the Pro Shop
- Maximum number of 4 people per group.
- 10 min tee intervals, again helps spread out players arrival and departure from the club
- 1 person per cart, unless 2 people who usually reside at the same address want to share a cart – when available
- Time sheets have been adjusted, and Conditions of Play added for acceptance.
- Members are encouraged to use the Miscore app.
- Flag sticks have been replaced in the cups, but there is a **STRICT** no tending or removing the flag stick local rule.
- Local Rule for flag sticks (07/05/2020) If a player either tends and/or removes the flagstick a 2 shot penalty applies.
- Bunker rakes have been removed there is a local rule for bunkers
- Local rule for bunkers (24/03/2020) players in a bunker, may, at any time, take relief by placing the ball within one club length in the bunker but no nearer the hole.
- All areas that have been sanded/reseeded on the course free relief within one club length no nearer the hole.
- To be read in conjunction with local rules on the back of the score card.

We need members to follow a very strict process each time they play:

- Only Arrive 10min before your tee time
- Come to the Pro Shop or the Office to register your attendance and head straight to the tee.
- Play your game observing all the on-course rules and physical distancing requirements.
- Players are encouraged not to loiter around the pro shop or outdoor area
- These protocols are also in place for the change rooms and toilets.
- If you do bring your dogs out for a walk please pick up any mess that they make as it could be your ball that lands in one!
- Please remember to fill in all divots and pitch marks.

Any person in a high risk category is strongly recommended to self-isolate as per the government recommendations.

Physical distancing requirements must be observed at all times, and healthy hygiene practices are encouraged.

Please note that this decision can be revoked at any time should a member not comply or if there is a change of directive from our peak body or Government. By reading this document, if you breach any of the Government Directives you are responsible for any penalties applied.

These rules will continue to be reviewed on a regular basis.
