

## RECIPROCAL RIGHTS AGREEMENT

Between Wollongong Golf Club and Geraldton Golf Club

Members of both clubs are eligible for reciprocal rights subject to and in accordance with the provisions set out below.

- Members of Wollongong Golf Club are entitled to enjoy reciprocal benefits at a number of partner clubs around the world.
- 7 day, 6 day, 5 day, Intermediate and Junior members only.
- Members of reciprocal clubs wishing to use the course facilities must advise of the reciprocal agreement at the time of booking.
- A letter of introduction is required for playing at all reciprocal clubs. Please see reception to make a reciprocal booking. Letters can be requested from reception also as required.
- Members shall be required to show proof of membership and current playing handicap
- Members of reciprocal clubs will receive privileges given to its own members in the equivalent category of membership.
- Visiting members of reciprocal clubs playing in the club's open competition are ineligible to win a club championship, monthly medal or donated trophies. Reciprocal rights are a privilege of membership. If you are exercising that privilege, please ensure that you comply with the reciprocal club's requirements and terms of conditions. To do otherwise may result in our arrangement being forfeited
- Reciprocal members have access to available amenities of the Club house subject to the Clubs by-laws and such conditions which exist from time to time as to the thereof, for example, dress rules, hours of operation, general decorum and acceptable standards of behaviour;
- The benefits provided apply only to members of reciprocal clubs who are temporarily visiting centres away from their normal residence. Members who reside or intend to take up residence within 100 kilometres radius of a reciprocal club are not eligible to avail these benefits;
- Either party giving six (2) months' notice in writing may cancel this agreement.
