2020 Young Guns Junior Invitational Tournament - Conditions of Play

1. The R&A and USGA Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Geraldton Golf Club shall be the Rules of Play during the tournament.
2. Entries must be made using the paper based entry form.
Entries close at 6.00 pm on Tuesday 15th September 2020. Late entries may be accepted.
3. All events are open to financial male and female Junior members of Clubs that are affiliated with Golf Australia who are under the Age of 18 as at 1st January 2020. Entrants must have an official Golf Link handicap.
4. All competitors shall be under the control of the Tournament Match Committee, which has the power to alter or vary the conditions as may be deemed desirable.
5. Entry fees are forfeited and non-transferable once the draw has been finalised.
6. If you do not have a Nominated partner for the Saturday event, one will be randomly allocated
7. The Tournament Match Committee reserves the right to ballot out sufficient entries to limit the field to such a number it considers a maximum manageable field.
8. Competitors must report to the Starter and be ready to play 15 minutes before their allocated time in the draw. Any competitor not on the tee when called is liable to be scratched. In the event of a cancellation the field may be moved up. The Starter may alter groups on the day of competition as required.
9. Any protest must be lodged at the Clubrooms with a member of the Tournament Match Committee within 10 minutes of the completion of the round in which the disputed matter has arisen.
10. The Tournament Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, either shorten any competition or fix another day and in the case of ties, decide on the manner in which they shall adjudicate. Final decisions rest with the Tournament Match Committee.
11. In the event of a tie for the Overall 36 holes event, a countback (as per Golf Australia's recommendation) will apply to determine the 36 Holes Winners.
12. Only players who have nominated and paid their entry fee in full by 6.00pm on Friday 18th September will be eligible to win overall prizes.
 - Single day players are only eligible to win the day prizes.
 - Players may only win one (1) trophy per day (excluding Novelties).
